

We made several walks this summer in the surrounding area of Saint Germain Lembron, formerly capital of the country called "Le Lambron".

The country of Lembron groups together several municipalities.

This small trip will allow us to pass successively in:

- St Gervasy (Norman church)
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- Ronzieres (parochial church of Vodable until 1789)
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- Collamine sous Vodable was priory dependant of the monastery of Sauxillanges (1030 ) until 1789.
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- Chalus: church of eleventh century, given around the year 1100 to the abbey of La Chaise-Dieu. This land belonged to the family of Chalus during more than seven centuries.
